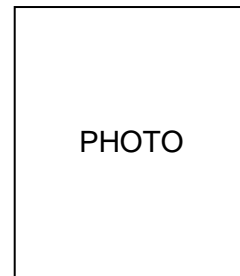

- 1 - A detailed C.V. (resume) including academic studies and professional experience
- 2 - **True copies of your Degree certificates with translations only in French language, approved by the French consulate in your country**
- 3 - English tests you have obtained (TOEFL, TOEIC, ...), with translation in French or English
- 4 - Transcripts – in French or English – of your grades for the degree you have obtained
- 5 - A brief summary of the curriculum of the degree programmes you have attended (copied from your handbook or your university website)
- 6 - Work and internship certificates
- 7 - One ID photo (to stick on the 1st page)
- 8 - A copy of your Passport

Master's degree in Languages, Business, European Management

ENGLISH LEVEL

To apply for the Master's degree in Languages, Business and European Management a minimum English level is required.

- If you come from an English speaking country or if you passed a Bachelor's or a Master's degree in English studies (Literature etc.) you won't have to have taken an English language level test before applying .
- If you are from a non English speaking country and you passed a diploma in a field other than English studies, you will have to present a minimum score at one of the following English tests :
