

Master's degree in Languages, Business and European Management

ENGLISH LEVEL

To apply for the Master's degree in Languages Business and European Management a minimum English level is required.

- If you come from an English-speaking country or if you have obtained a Bachelor's or a Master's degree in English studies (literature, linguistics etc.) you will not have to take an English language level test before applying. The selection board might request an interview by means of videoconference.

FRENCH LEVEL

To apply for the Master's degree in Languages Business and European Management a minimum French level is required.

- If you have obtained a Bachelor's or a Master's degree in French studies (literature, linguistics etc.) you will not have to take a French language level test before applying. The selection board might request an interview by means of videoconference.
- If you passed a diploma in a field other than French studies, you will have to present a minimum score at one of the following French tests: TCF, DELF, DALF. This corresponding CEFR level is B2 (proficiency).
