## The Euraxess Mobility Center is here to guide you

European
Charter for
Researchers

Implemented in 2006 on a regional scale, the mobility center was awarded the Euraxess label in 2008.

<u>Information can be provided by e-mail, Teams meetings, telephone and appointments on request:</u>

- Reception procedures: reception agreements → allow one month to obtain a signed reception agreement, visa and residence permit applications. Interactions may occur with the French Prefecture and CPAM in case of extreme emergency,
- Support in finding accommodation,
- Administrative and legal assistance,
- Helping researchers and doctoral students **integrate** into local, social and cultural life, and participating in events organized by the International Relations Central Office for doctoral students.
- End-of-stay administrative procedures.

Mobility experiences should be taken into account in the career progression and assessment of researchers.

Employers should enable researchers to have a wide range of experiences (mobility in all its forms).

Employers should promote the free movement of researchers
