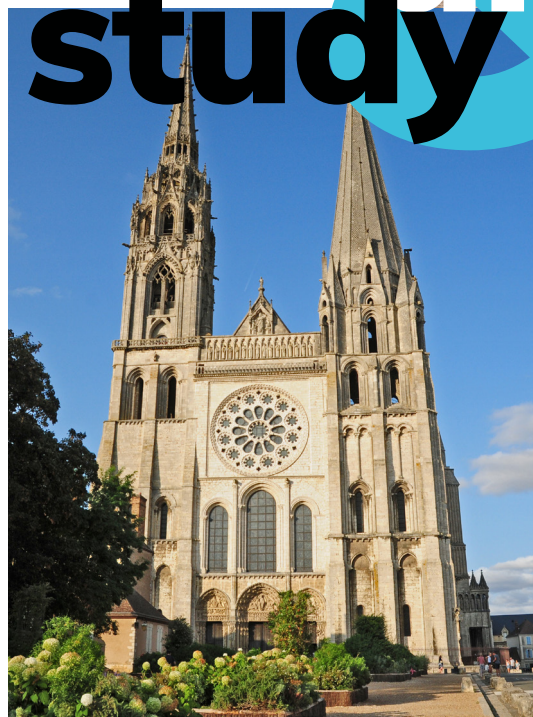


Our institution, INSPÉ Centre Val de Loire, has 6 training centers in the whole region.

Language requirements

Courses are taught in French. A B2 level is compulsory in the teaching language.

French Language Courses

International students can register to the French courses taught at the French Institute on our Campus and be awarded with ECTS. These courses need to be added on the learning agreement of the students.

Tuition Fees

Exchange students do not pay any tuition fees for the courses attended at INSPÉ Centre Val de Loire.

A fee of 65€ / semester will have to be paid to the French Institute if French courses are added to the learning agreement.

Students must pick up courses from the same level to prevent courses from overlapping.

Accommodation

After nomination, the International Office provides students with information to find accommodation in student halls.

Welcome Center

International officers will help the incoming students to register to the courses and other administrative tasks. They will also propose activities and meetings to help students to discover the area and make new friends.
